The purpose of this letter is to inform you and your students about a NEW \$2500 Scholarship. This scholarship is offered to a 2017 graduate of our 27 Catholic High Schools in Nebraska. This award is for any incoming Freshman who will enroll at either the University of Nebraska–Lincoln *or* The University of Nebraska-Kearney.

This scholarship will be administered by the University of Nebraska Foundation, and is sponsored by the men of Delta Tau Delta Fraternity. It will be divided into two semesters, and will offset their tuition statement. The application deadline is nearing very quickly, due May 1, 2017. We will be much earlier with the applications next year.

- 2) Transcript.
- 3) Essay 500 words or less to answer these questions:

"This scholarship honors a student with excellent academic performance, demonstrated leadership, and a commitment of community service. Describe your intentions in each of these areas while at The University of Nebraska. At this point, what are your long-term career plans and interests? How will you get there?"

Additionally, the Undergraduate members of the Beta Tau Chapter of Delta Tau Delta sponsor other scholarships for a total of \$1000 (\$500 and two @ \$250) for any incoming Freshman to UNL only. These applicants can be from any high school, including out of state students. Application instructions are on the same web page and emailed to the same address. Please encourage your students to apply for both scholarships.

This scholarship is available to any incoming Freshman who will graduate from one of our Nebraska Catholic High Schools; and intends to attend either the University of Nebraska-Lincoln *or* the University of Nebraska-Kearney.
