MARCH FOR LIFE: SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

All applicants must be current high school students who live within the Archdiocese of Omaha. Amounts will be awarded according to the merit of the Youth Essay and the financial need of the pilgrim’s household. Applying for aid does not hold your registration spot. Please, contact your parish or school to register.

Application Deadline: October 2, 2017

Award Announcement: October 6, 2017

Include the following:

- 1) This form completed
- 2) Youth Essay – Answer the question, “Why would you like to attend the March for Life?”
 - a. 250-500 words in length
 - b. Submitted on standard 8.5” by 11” paper
 - c. Typed essays preferred
- 3) Parent/Guardian Statement of Need – Answer the question, “Why does your youth need financial aid in order to attend the March for Life?”
 - a. No more than 500 words
 - b. Submitted on standard 8.5” by 11” paper
 - c. Typed essays preferred

Note: Full scholarships (\$475) are highly competitive. If your youth is applying for a full scholarship, consider including the following: household income, number of children, or other factors contributing to the need for aid.

Note: For those with multiple youths applying from one household, the same statement of need may be used for each. Reprint the statement and include it with a separate application for each youth.

Check all scholarships for which you would like to be considered.

Note: Please, refer to scholarship eligibility.

- Nebraska Knights of Columbus Culture of Life Foundation (\$50+):** Applicants may not have received assistance for the March for Life Pilgrimage from the Archdiocese in the past.
- Nebraskan’s United for Life (\$475):** Applicants may not have received a full scholarship in the past.
