

Board of Governors Merit Scholarship

The Board of Governors Merit Scholarship is based on academic achievement as demonstrated on the students ACT or Accuplacer test scores. The award is for full tuition for a maximum of four consecutive academic semesters (fall & spring terms only) for a student starting college in the fall term and who graduated from high school the previous school year.

Successful candidates must meet the following criteria:

- Complete the Board of Governors Scholarship Application and Admissions Applications prior to March 1, 2018
- Be a current high school student with an expected graduation date during the 2017-2018 academic school year from a high school within the Northeast service area
- Be a current resident of Nebraska. Achieve an ACT composite test score of 23 or higher, or a minimum of the following on the Accuplacer Test: College Level 63; Reading 102; Sentence Skills 104
- > Enroll as a full-time degree-seeking student at Northeast for the fall term following graduation from high school
- Maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.50 and meet the financial aid standards of satisfactory academic progress each semester.
