Each year the Dodge Chamber of Commerce recognizes a local high school senior for their outstanding academic achievements, extra curricular strengths and civil/community involvement. The scholarship recipient should show exemplary academic discipline, community mindfulness, club/organization involvement and leadership abilities and have chosen to continue education to college, university or formal vocational training. The scholarship monies awarded are the result of the generosity of members of the Dodge Chamber of Commerce and the Dodge community-at-large, through tier commitment of time, monetary donations, fund raising and resources.


Two payments, one each of \$500.00 per semester from the Dodge Chamber of Commerce will be paid directly to the post-secondary institution. Recipient will have until December 31st of award year to make final arrangements of scholarship funds.

GENERAL CRITERIA

- MUST be a citizen or resident of the United States of America. If the applicant's
 transcript reflects a place of birth other than the United States, appropriate proof of
 citizenship must be furnished (i.e., a copy of the photo page of a valid U.S. passport, copy
 of Naturalization certificate or a birth certificate for U.S. Citizen Born Abroad).
- MUST be a high school graduating senior.
- MUST be accepted to an accredited post-secondary educational institution and enrolled within 6 months or graduation.
- MUST register as a full-time student.
- MUST have a 2.75 or better cumulative High School Grade Point Average (GPA), provide verification at the completion of the first semester of senior year.

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- MUST provide two signed letters of recommendation from people who have known you
 for more than 2 years and who are not related to you. One of the letters must be from a
 teacher.
- A face to face interview may be required as well as newspaper recognition and attendance at a monthly Dodge Chamber of Commerce Meeting.
- MUST volunteer community service (minimum of 5 hours) in a Dodge service organization or one of the affiliated Dodge Chamber of Commerce Businesses or events.

APPLICATION GUIDELINES

- Submit all information on 8 ½ X 11 sheets of plain white paper.
- Complete a cover page; including your full name, address, High School, signature and date.
- The application has 5 short answer questions and a three part essay; please retype the
 question above each answer. Answer the questions in no more than 150 words and the
 essay in no more than 500 words.
- Weighted consideration will be given to answers and essays demonstrating excellent grammar, spelling, punctuation and the ability to express themselves.

SHORT ANSWER QUESTIONS

- 1. What are your interests and accomplishments?
- What are your future plans and life goals?
- 3. What is your reason(s) for pursuing your chosen career path?
- 4. When did a time for "hard work" pay off?
- 5. What was your experience with your Community service or Chamber of Commerce business volunteering?

THREE PART ESSAY QUESTION

If you were to return to your community following your education,

- How would you be involved in the community?
- 2. What would you do to improve it?
- 3. How does your chosen career help accomplish these improvements?
