



The terms of your McIntosh-Davis/Chambers Scholar Commitments are as follows:

1. An amount not to exceed \$2000 will be credited to your student account at Northeast, half in the fall and half in the spring.
2. You must enroll for at least 12 credit hours (nine graded hours) during each term of the academic year (fall, winter and spring quarters) and successfully complete 24 credit hours each academic year. Repeated courses only count once.
3. This commitment will be discontinued if you withdraw from school or fail to register during the next four academic years, unless an exception is granted in advance of the period of absence because of special circumstances.
4. It is generally expected that all McIntosh-Davis/Chambers Scholars will maintain a cumulative grade-point of 2.25 or higher throughout their four years of undergraduate study.
5. You will be required to be an active participant as determined by your institution and as outlined in your agreement letter.
6. You must submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) as soon as possible after October 1 each year and not later than April 1. This application can be filed electronically at <http://www.fafsa.gov>.

How to Apply for the McIntosh Davis/Chambers Scholarship:

1. Apply for Admission at Northeast.
2. Take a College Placement Test.
3. File a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
4. Complete the attached McIntosh-Davis/Chambers Application and submit to Northeast Community College by April 1, 2019.
