HEART OF A CHILD MINISTRIES

Heart of a Child Ministries – an Omaha based pro-life education ministry – will be presenting to **grades 7-12** on **Wednesday, December 5th**. Heart of a Child brings live ultrasounds into schools with professional ultrasound technicians and pregnant volunteers. Students see the miracle of life in the womb, listen to the heart beat, and hear the truth about God’s love for the unborn and all of His children through Scripture and Church teaching.

Junior high students are gently introduced to the topic of abortion through the story of the Pro-life Prayer Pillows, which were inspired by a seven-year old child in prayer. High school students hear testimonials from people who: were involved in the abortion industry and converted, chose adoption or are adoptive moms.

All students are encouraged to participate in a pro-life action to support families in their respect for life. Therefore, **GACC is sponsoring a Pro-Life Penny Drive House Competition**. Each 7th-12th grader is asked to bring in spare change **between now and Dec. 5th**. The four houses will compete to collect the most pennies. All silver coins deposited in House jars will be deducted from that House’s collection totals. GACC will then present all donations to Heart of a Child Ministries on the day of the event.
