


- For more than 135 years, Guardian Angels Central Catholic has been helping West Point area children prepare for life's journey.

But we need to fund the gap between incomes and expenses to meet our growth demands and upgrade aging facilities.



Invest in our teachers and staff

- > 85% of GACC's school budget of \$3.4 Million is employee salaries & benefits
- Teachers and staff deserve competitive compensation for their dedication to GACC and Catholic education
- Our people are valuable to our success and contribute to our community beyond teaching
- Funds 5 years at current projections

<u>Upgrade essential campus</u> <u>infrastructure</u>

- Ensure our environment is conducive to both teaching and learning
- HVAC in all buildings
- Renovations to restrooms & locker rooms
- Replace & reseal windows
- Insulation
- Fire suppression system
- Tuck point masonry
- Roof on old gym

PHASE 2: LONG TERM NEEDS After the first \$6 million is raised...

Create a new educational addition to our campus community.

- The 1st investment in infrastructure on our campus in a generation!
- ✓ \$2.5-\$3 million estimate
 - Includes materials, labor, professional fees, & construction costs
- ✓ The decision hasn't been made yet about what that new addition will look like. An integrative building committee is being formed.
- The GACC Board of Limited Jurisdiction will make the final decision.




