The purpose of these scholarships is to award outstanding Cuming County High School Graduates scholarships to recognize their accomplishments and assist in their pursuit of a post-secondary education in Agriculture.

Requirements ...

Graduates who wish to be considered for a Cuming County Feeders Scholarship must:

- Be a resident of Cuming County
- be a graduating senior planning to pursue a degree with an agricultural major
- be planning to continue their post-secondary education at a vocational school, junior college, or four year institution
- submit an application and accompanying materials by March 15
- use funds within one year of presentation

Application Materials

Submit the following information by no later than March 15:

- A resume (not to exceed 2 pages) including, but not limited to, the following ...
 - Leadership positions
 - Community service activities participated in through school or other organizations
 - Intended major or area of emphasis being pursued
 - Job experience
 - Honors or awards received in agriculture and other related activities
 - Other leadership activities in school and/or the community
- A brief essay describing your intended college major, future goals and career aspirations
- The Counselor Information Sheet

Notification of Recipients

- Notification of the recipients and alternate will be made by letter by early April
- Scholarship funds will be made available directly to the recipient and the college after they have begun classes.
