Financial report:

Old Business:

- Side by side fundraiser- 180 tickets sold. 77 tickets to be sold/turned in by students yet. 8 turned back in by students as they are not selling them. Trivia Night made \$835. \$200 went toward purchasing 2 tickets to give away, so \$635 into the Booster account.
- 125 Supper- \$? \$11,000 made on alcohol sales.
- Beer and Bingo- April 22, Liquor license has been approved. Tickets available for \$25. Jason Minnick volunteered to MC for the night.
- The Bluejay tournament for March 3-8th has been canceled due to low registration numbers.
- Alumni tournament- March 25-26. Liquor license is in.
- Catholic schools' weekly breakfast made \$2305.50. Averaged about \$10.25 a per plate donation.
- Tailgate suppers.

- Nacho Bar on 2/25/22 made \$740 and was sponsored by Good Earth.
- Second round spirit wear made \$360.
- Weight equipment from Cedar Catholic is installed and being used.

AD Business:

- Volleyball uniforms had a donation and have been ordered.
- Football uniforms have had a donation also and are in the process of being ordered.
- Wrestling singlets are due this next year. Being looked at.
- Jason Minnick here to discuss gym issues. Estimates from Sports Facility Maintenance from Omaha came out and looked at side hoops in GA gym. The backboards are flawed and that's why the one fell. The company that we got them from will replace them. There was an inspection report for the whole gym. The report needs to be presented to the parish council, as it is their gym. Bleacher inspection quote is \$1,095.00 (just to inspect the bleachers). Motion made by Danelle and second by Sarah to have the company come inspect the bleachers. Quote for new gym is pads \$8,679.13. This includes pads for both gyms.
- Football bleachers- Jason Minnick is going to look at them tomorrow. Will move them to Beemer while the ground is still frozen. Work to the bleachers and field will be done this summer so they can be installed by this fall. Will give a check for \$1 to Wisner Lyons club to purchase the bleachers.
- Jason Folkers is going to talk to the school board about having a cross country team next year.

New Business:

- Start thinking about finding people who would be interested in being vice president and president for next year. Reach out to your grades and ask around to friends who may be willing to take on these positions next year. Will come up with a rough draft calendar for the next school year to divide up tasks to each grade. Each grade rep can then reach out to parents to help when needed.
- For next year Danelle will assign duties to reps. This way everyone will know their role and can help with finding helpers for duties.
- Steak supper- March 23. Will get a flier to school to put in family envelopes. Nielsen center will cost \$325 rather than \$175. Will probably have enough help. Will offer service hours to students.
- Wrestling mat- sample mat shown. Still waiting on the final quote. Will be around \$8000 to \$9000.
- There were no hot dogs or pizza for the speech meat, only pork sandwiches. Several students asked for pizza and hotdogs. Will make sure to have those available for next year's speech meet.
- Father Weeder- Will probably be doing a capital campaign coming up. Trying to hold off on some of the fund raisers. Jason has not been offered the AD position for next year. He was offered a letter of intent and he signed it.
