- Children should not be unattended or in the basement of the Activities Center when extracurriculars are going on upstairs.

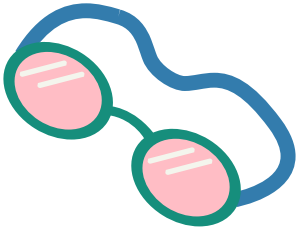

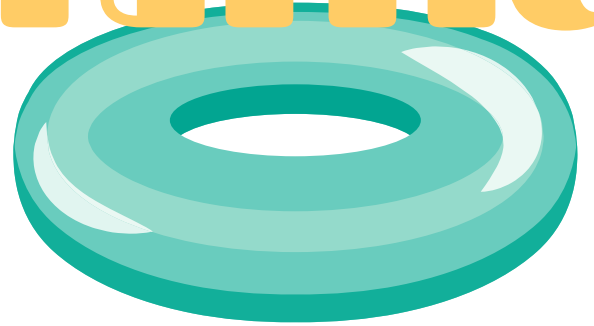

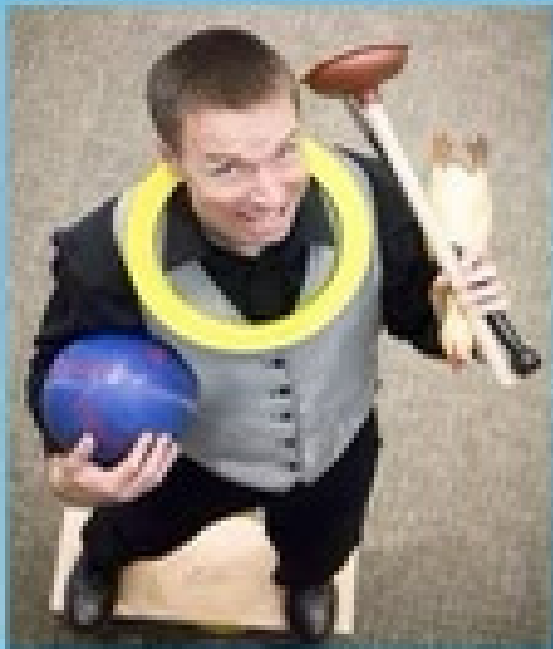

Am I Eligible?

Is my family eligible to receive a scholarship?

- Scholarships are based on financial need, following income guidelines similar to the National School Lunch Program. Please see the CSF website for our most recent income scale: www.csfomaha.org

What grades are eligible to receive a CSF scholarship?

- CSF awards scholarships for children in grades K-8 to any private or parochial school of their family's choosing.

Are siblings of my CSF scholar able to receive a scholarship?

- Yes, once you are qualified every K-8 child in your family is eligible to receive a scholarship.

Can I transfer my scholarship to a different private school?

- Yes, you may apply your CSF scholarship to a different private or parochial school on our list, should you decide to transfer.

How much will my child's scholarship be?

- Current scholarship amounts range from **\$400-\$1,100**, and the same amount is awarded to each child in your family. Please note that a **CSF scholarship does NOT cover full tuition at a private school.**

CSF scholarship requirements

Once awarded a scholarship, families must adhere to CSF's scholarship requirements to continue to receive assistance. For more details, please visit our website: www.csfomaha.org

A Parent's Choice

CSF Omaha has no religious affiliation and is destination neutral. Families who receive a scholarship choose the school that best fits their children's needs.

A Family Commitment

Every family who receives a scholarship must contribute \$500 to their child's education, and each scholar must achieve a minimum attendance rate of 90%.

A Commitment until Graduation

Once a child receives a scholarship, they will continue to do so until 8th grade graduation.
