
Teacher Faith Formation with the Evangelium Institute



NEW MOBILE "WEB" APP

This "web" app is replacing the current app that is downloaded from the App Stores. It offers all the same features as our current app and much more to come. **Please**, **delete the old app and use this one!** In the new app, you are able to access documents attached to news articles and it shows your child's service hours.

To get started **using** the new app, simply, go to a web browser on your phone and type in **sycamore.school**. Notice, there is no www! Sycamore recommends using Safari on an iPhone and Chrome on an Android. You will be prompted for our school code (1189) and then your family username and password.

TIP: You can, also, save this as an icon on your Home Screen for both Android and iPhone. Go to sycamore.school in your browser. Click the share button . Swipe up. Then, select Add to Home Screen.



Dear Parents.

This year we are holding our 2nd annual Jay Run at Neligh Park on Monday, October 2. This will be a fun-filled event for our K-12 students. Enclosed you will find a schedule that includes the times the students will head to the park to either run or walk laps. Parents, you are invited to come watch the event if you are able.

We are also using this event as a **fundraiser to support ongoing maintenance for the activity center and our fields**. We are asking students to participate in a pledge
drive in order to raise funds. **This packet includes instructions on how to register students for the fundraiser and the different options our friends and family may contribute**. It is a simple process and allows you to make requests for contributions
using the email addresses of prospective donors. Once you enter the prospective
donor's email and click submit, they will receive a digital flier asking them to make a
secure donation using a credit card. The online system keeps track of your pledges and
automatically sends the donor a thank you and receipt. **In this packet you will also find a pledge sheet if your student has individuals who prefer to make a donation using cash or check**. Please read on for more detailed instructions. **Thank you in advance for helping support our schools!**

Guardian Angels Central Catholic Jay Run

For our Jay Run this year, we're using an awesome web based fundraising system that makes it **much** easier for you to request pledges from your family and friends, and for them to make secure credit card donations online. It's fun, it's easy, and people who use it typically raise twice as much as those who don't!

Remember, our <u>Jay Run is October 2, so please register now to</u> help our school raise as much as we can for the activity center and field maintenance.

Using your computer's browser:

- Go to http://pledgestar.com/gacc
- Click "Not Registered For This Year's Event"
- Enter your name and email address, then click "Submit"
- Follow the instructions on-screen to register Jogger(s) and add family and friends

Using your Android or Apple phone or tablet:

- Go to the Apple App Store on IOS or the Amazon App Store on Android and search for "PledgeStar" to download the Family App, or go to https://pledgestar.com/gacc/downloadapp.html
- On the home screen enter your event code: "gacc" to locate your event
- Click "Not Registered For This Year's Event"
- Enter your name and email address, then click "Submit"
- Follow the instructions on-screen to register Jogger(s) and add family and friends

When you finish, the system emails pledge requests to your family and friends, and allows them to make secure credit card donations online. You get notified each time a pledge is made, and you can track your pledge progress online. Call 1-888-598-7510 if you need help.

Important Dates to Remember:

October 2 - Jay Run and any paper pledge forms due in office.

October 6 - All online pledges due that will count toward prizes.

PledgeStar-FAQ:

Q: Do I need to use both the paper pledge sheet AND the PledgeStar website?

A: No! We included the paper pledge sheets for families that prefer not to do fundraising using the web based option or who would like to use both options. If you use PledgeStar, you do not need to record any donations made through PledgeStar on your paper pledge sheet.

Q: I have more than one child at GACC. Do I have to set up more than one donation site on PledgeStar?

A: No! PledgeStar is built to handle multiple children from one family. On the setup page, simply add "participants" until all of your children are listed. When sharing the same PledgeStar accounts, donations will be divided equally between your children under the same household. For example, if you donate \$200 and you have two children, each child will receive credit for \$100. If your children prefer to have separate PledgeStar accounts, then you will need to register with different email addresses per student.

Q: How do I (as a parent) donate to my own child's fundraising efforts through PledgeStar?

A: Easy! Just click on the Donate button on your child's PledgeStar fundraising page. Alternatively, list yourself as an email recipient (it can be the same email you used to set up your account) on the "enter friends and family" section. When you send out donor request emails, you will get an email just like all your other friends and family. Simply click on the link in the email and donate to your child.

Q: Is credit card information secure using this new online system?

A: Yes, by using the online PledgeStar website, all transactions are secure.

Q: I have already donated once through PledgeStar and would like to donate additional money. Why won't the website let me donate again? How can I make an additional donation?

A: PledgeStar does not allow you to donate more than once to reduce the number of duplicate payments made in error. You have two options: 1) You can send in a check or cash through your student's paper pledge envelope. 2) Send yourself a new PledgeStar request to a new email address.

Q: Who do I contact if I have additional questions or need extra help?
